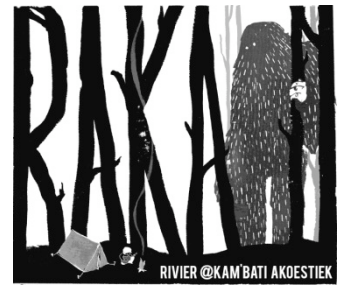


## VENDOR INFO & APPLICATIONS

### **RAKA Unplugged Music Festival 12-14 Feb 2010 Kam'Bati River Resort, Swellendam**



Raka rustig man! **RAKA**, the chilliest, grooviest music festival in the country is soon to overflow the Breede River's banks again. Set at the breathtaking **Kam'Bati River Resort** outside Swellendam, the third RAKA Unplugged Festival takes place on **12-14 February 2010**.

The intimate, relaxed atmosphere, excellent facilities and beautiful surroundings make this an ideal breakaway for families, friends, students or even couples on a Valentines expedition. A whole weekend of camping, swimming in the river, lounging in the sun and experiencing some of SA's best muso's live and **unplugged**, is further enhanced with a variety of fun activities, food & drink and crafts.

This is an opportunity for traders in unique, high quality foods, arts or crafts to display and sell their wares at RAKA 2010. If you'd like to participate in RAKA 2010, please read through the information below before submitting your application.

#### **Rates:**

- R800 (excluding VAT), to be paid in advance, by no later than 8 February 2010.
- This includes a site of approx 3.5m x 3.5m, parking for one vehicle and two entry tickets. Vendors are responsible for all their own display tables, gazebos, camping gear, etc.
- Further entry tickets may be purchased via Computicket at R250 per person. The early bird special price is R200 until 15 January 2010.
- Vendors who need more space can apply for two adjacent sites for a further R400 (excl. VAT).
- Vendors who need power supply for their stalls must state so in their applications.
- Traders are welcome to park and camp either behind their stall sites, or in the public camping area. However, keep in mind that space behind the stalls and access to the trading area will be limited during the festival.

#### **Trading times:**

- All vendors must set up and be open for business before 12:00 on Friday 12/02/10. Vendors who fail to set up in time may run the risk of forfeiting their sites, and will not be refunded for rent money paid in advance.
- Stalls must remain for the whole of the festival and can be vacated as from 13:00 on Sunday 14/02/10.

- Vendors can determine their own trading times, but we recommend that you trade for as long hours as possible to optimise business and the experience of festival-goers.

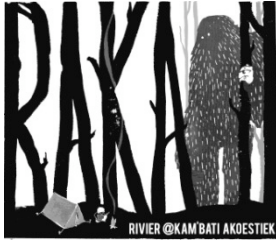
### **Terms & conditions:**

- No illegal, dangerous, counterfeit, obscene, harmful or toxic goods may be sold.
- No traders may use, sell or display the RAKA festival's name or logo on any merchandise or free goods.
- No traders (other than the official appointed RAKA merchandisers) may sell or display any merchandise of artists/bands performing at the festival.
- No firearms, weapons, glass/bottles, illegal substances, reckless, offensive or dangerous behaviour or disturbing noise levels (such as high-fi's, car boot music, etc.) will be permitted.
- Food traders must take all the necessary measures to ensure that their goods are prepared, stored and sold as hygienically and safely as possible; to protect food against contamination or spoilage and to refrain from harming the environment in any way.
- To this end, stall vendors must provide their own fire extinguishers, hand washing facilities, gloves, utensils for food handling, freezers for perishables, waste water and refuse containers with lids, etc.
- All traders must display their name/business name, address and contact details at their stalls.

### **Application process:**

- Traders who wish to obtain stalls for RAKA 2010 can apply now by filling out the accompanying form and submitting it via **email: [alette@dpk.co.za](mailto:alette@dpk.co.za) or fax: 086 590 5660** by **no later than 5 February 2010**.
- The organisers will review all applications and notify successful applicants. We will try to avoid duplication and maintain the highest quality possible. You can help in this regard by supplying as much detail (preferably supplicated with pictures) as possible about the sort of produce you wish to display.
